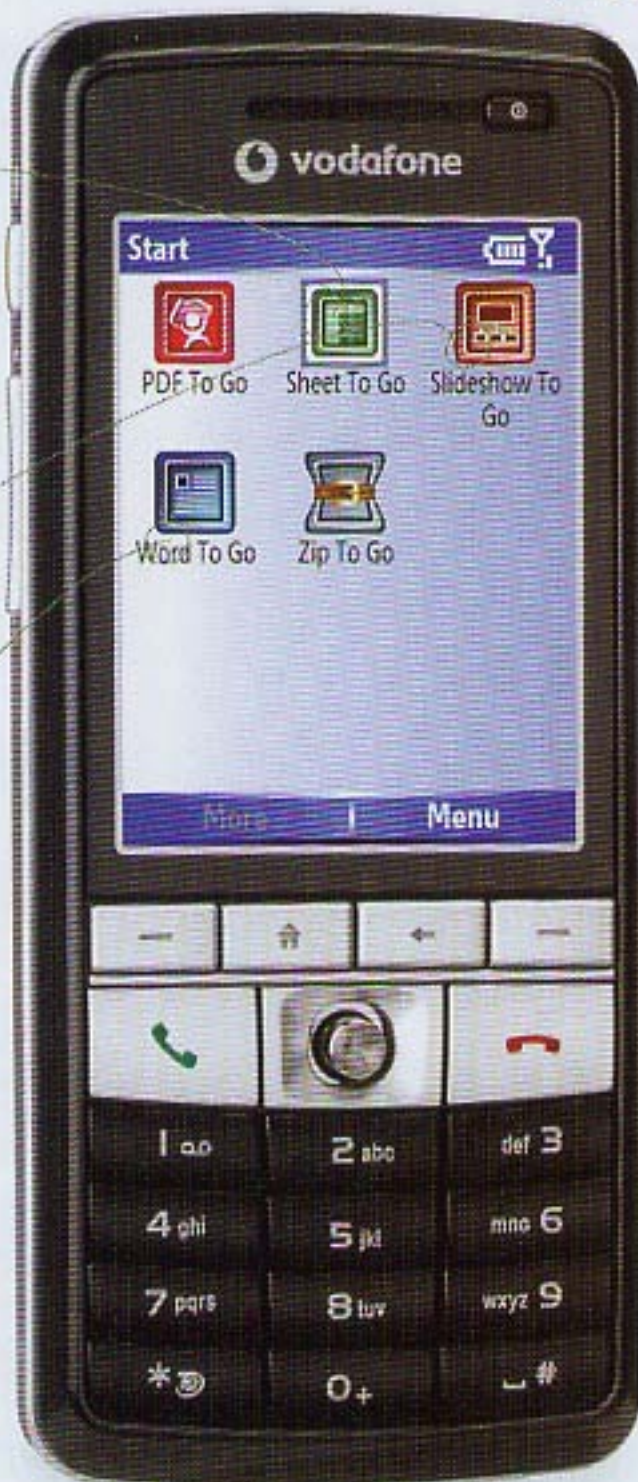

Documents To Go is the first Microsoft Office editor for the Windows Mobile for Smartphone OS. Install it now and in a few minutes you could be viewing, editing and even creating Office documents on the fly

Summary: Work with Microsoft Office documents while mobile

Smartphone technology is still relatively new, and Windows Mobile handsets have opened a new chapter in mobile phone technology.

They combine the best of mobile voice and data communications with the best of personal info management solutions. But although the WM5 for Smartphone platform is very powerful, it has limitations, and the most notable is lack of built-in support for MS Office documents: you can't view, edit or create Office documents on an 'out of the box' Smartphone.

This seems rather strange, especially as mobile devices are no longer viewed simply as electronic replacements for paper-based calendars and address books. In fact, for many, access to MS Office documents is just as important. So how can the lack of built-in support for MS Office be explained?

The primary reason is the absence of a suitable data entry method. For instance, would you really want to type even a short word-processed document using your handset's keypad? However, the recent proliferation and availability of external keyboards means that it's now theoretically possible to edit existing Office documents

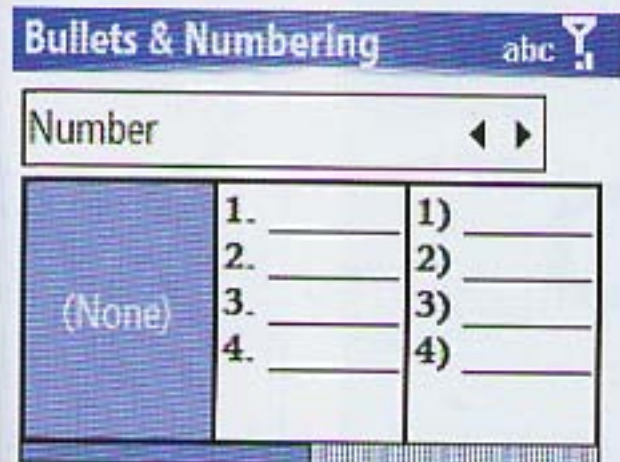

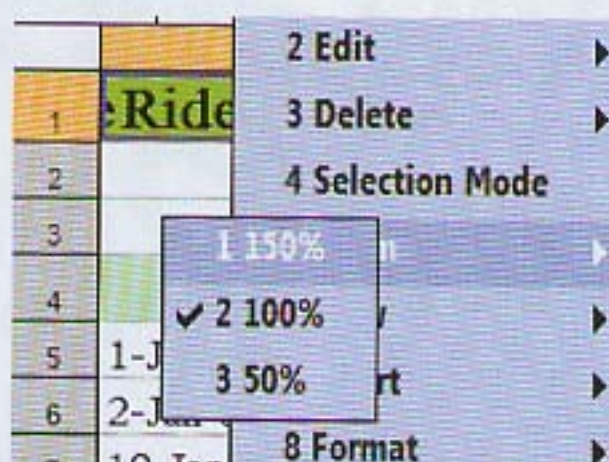
I want to view, not edit Office documents on my i-mate SP5. Are there any Office document viewers available?

Try RepliGo (www.cerience.com) or ClearVue Office (www.westtek.com). These are applications designed to enable you to view Office files on a Smartphone.

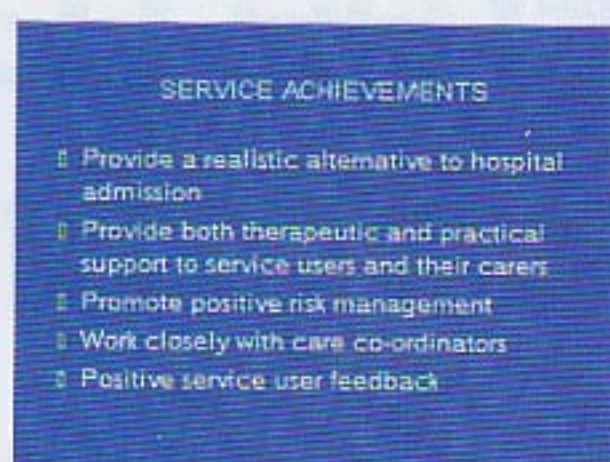

Word To Go has a first-rate feature set. Formatting options include support for bullets and numbering – great for helping you create professional-looking docs while you're away from home or the office.



Edit and view spreadsheets
Comprehensive number and cell formatting is included, and you can zoom in on spreadsheets for ease of viewing. The number of sheets per workbook is limited only by a mobile device's memory.



Check PowerPoint slides
As with all the components of Documents To Go, the formatting of your PowerPoint presentations survives transfer from mobile device to desktop PC and vice versa, fully intact.

Word To Go

Use Word To Go to view, edit or create Microsoft Word files on your Palm PDA or Windows Mobile Smartphone. Features include password protection, embedded support for graphics and the ability to edit and view footnotes and comments. You can even insert tables into documents and edit the content and layout while away from home or the office.

SlideShow To Go

If you are an avid PowerPoint user, then SlideShow To Go may well prove indispensable as this handy component is designed to let you view, edit and create PowerPoint presentations while on the move. Features include three view modes (Outline, Slide and Notes) and six zoom levels, great for allowing you to quickly and easily edit or view your slides while away from the office.

PDF To Go

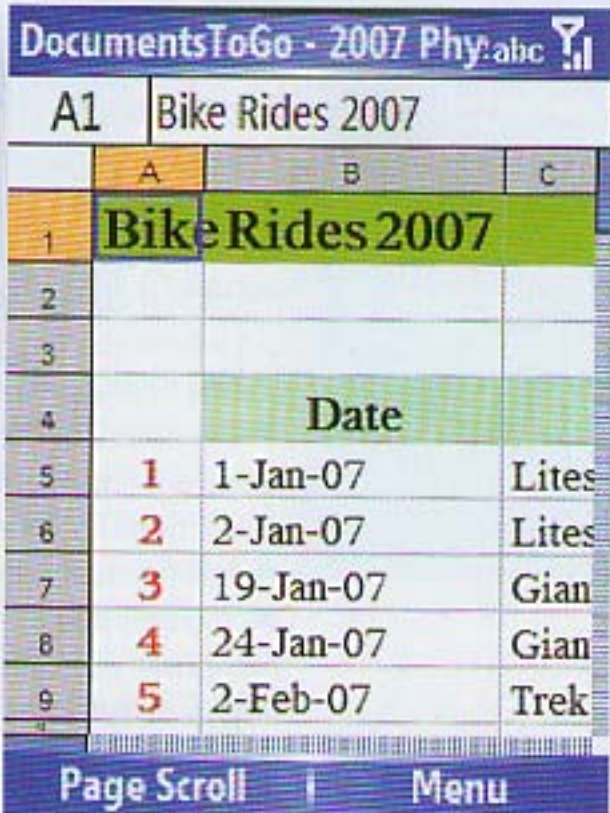
Documents To Go also includes a PDF file viewer, and this can be used to open and view RC4-encrypted PDF files, PDF email attachments and even password-protected documents. Support for high resolution means that you get a clear and detailed view of your files, and nine zoom levels (including Fit to Screen and Fit to Width) ensures that browsing the content of your documents is easy on the eyes.

Zip To Go

As a bonus, this outstanding Office editing solution also includes a component called Zip To Go. This handy utility can be used to open compressed file attachments or ZIP archives directly on your Palm PDA or Smartphone. Zip To Go is easy to use and it has several useful features. For example, you have the option of extracting single files or all those included in an archive.
